# **Discussion:**

- 1. Approval of July Meeting Minutes:

- 3. Pedestrian Pathways
  - a. Don and Pat met with representatives of Van Buren County Road Commission (VBCRC) to discuss options for resurfacing CR690.
  - b. VBCRC seemed receptive to repaving CR690 and including pedestrian markings with significant contributions from Keeler Township and CIA. Additionally, they discussed a plan for 95<sup>th</sup> Ave. to be chipped, fog sealed, and painted with sharrows with funding provided by Keeler Township as part of the larger project.
  - c. Keeler Township board has approved an allocation of \$100,000 for the CR690 project spanning the 2024-2025 fiscal year.
  - d. Brian presented a draft resolution for an allocation of \$100,000 from the CIA based on information received from the meeting with the VBCRC.
    - i. Discussion ensued and draft was edited.
